Make sure the power is shut off. The safest way to do this is to switch the large red button to "off" in the fuse box.

Allow the bulb to cool down before touching it. It's easy to burn yourself on an old bulb.

turn off the power

helpful hints

Ensure you can safely reach the bulb by using the right equipment.

Don't stand on furniture!

Take the bulb out of the socket by twisting it counter-clockwise until it comes out of the socket.

climb a ladder

dispose of the bulb

To do so, insert a new bulb lightly but firmly into the socket and twist clockwise until it won't go any further.

Throw away the old bulb safely because the glass is fragile and very sharp. To do so, put the old bulb into the packaging of the new bulb for safe disposal.

restore power

remove the bulb Once the bulb is installed, turn the power back on by switching the large red button to "on" in the fuse box *Check the wattage on the used bulb and replace it with a bulb of the same wattage.

*Dispose of the bulb well out of reach of children. *Don't put your fingers in the exposed light socket.
