<b>seem</b> He seems a bit too meticulous to me.
<b>look</b> She looks hard-working.
<b>suggest</b> His extravagance suggests a need to be noticed.
<b>display</b> In this situation, he displayed his generosity.

<b>reminds me of...</b> His demanding personality reminds me of a foreign dictator.
