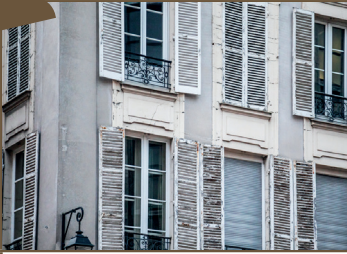

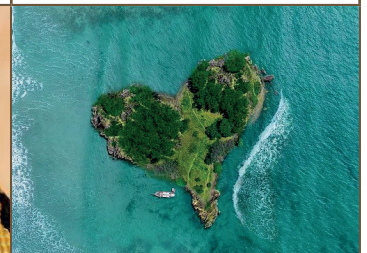

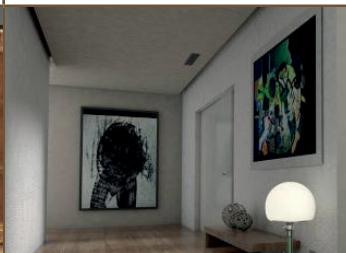

Singular nouns:

keep the regular article

Plural nouns:

add the article *any* for negatives and ?'s

Do you have a dog? → No, I don't have a dog.

Do you have any Polish friends → No, I don't have any Polish friends.
